School Community

Ranked #1 Private High School on The Washington Post's Jay Mathews Challenge Index

Founded in 1934, Pine Crest is an independent, all-faith co-educational pre-kindergarten through grade twelve day school. We have 2,671 students on two campuses in Boca Raton and Fort Lauderdale with a 98% overall retention rate in the Upper School (2019-20 to 2020-21). Students of color represent 33% of the Upper School, and 17% of students receive Financial and Inclusion Aid.

COVID-19 Response

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Pine Crest School transitioned to distance learning on March 16, 2020 for the remainder of the second semester. Our distance learning model featured a combination of synchronous and asynchronous instruction. Our grading system and academic policies were not changed. For the 2020-21 academic year, Pine Crest is offering in-person instruction five days per week with an option for students to continue distance learning. The distance learning model is fully synchronous.

Grading

Pine Crest School does not rank students. The transcript provides a weighted cumulative core grade point average and is calculated as follows:

AP and Post AP course weighting = +1.0 Honors course weighting = +0.5

Calendar and Curriculum

Pine Crest is on a semester academic calendar with a 9 period school day with 43-minute periods. For our full curriculum guide, <u>click here</u>.

24 credits are required in grades 9 through 12 for graduation. Upper School students are required to take:

4 years of English and mathematics 3 years of social science and world language

3 years of science plus physics in grade eight 1.5 credits of humanities and fine arts

5.5 credits of electives

Special Curricular Features

Pine Crest offers 17 Post-AP seminars taught at levels beyond the AP curriculum and noted on transcript.

Science Research Program: Twelve students selected by committee enter the program at the end of ninth grade and continue through twelfth grade. Students design experiments, write research papers, present findings, and submit work to regional and national symposia and research venues.

Advanced Placement

Pine Crest offers 32 Advanced Placement courses. 2,432 exams were taken in May 2020. 83% of the AP exams taken scored 3 or higher.
