Curriculum

Spanish River offers a college preparatory curriculum. Courses offered include regular, honors, Advanced Placement (AP), Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE), ESE, and dual enrollment. Course selection includes 74 honors courses, 25 AP courses, and 15 AICE courses offered in English, Math, Science, Social Studies, Foreign Language, Business, and Fine Arts. In 2019, Spanish River students took 2805 AP exams and 1133 AICE exams. Dual Enrollment courses are offered through Florida Atlantic University and Palm Beach State College.

Spanish River offers three Choice Career Academies, which include the Biotechnology Academy, Entrepreneurial Academy, and the American History & Law Academy. Students in these academies will take courses to meet their graduation requirements as well as electives in their academy area of study. Through community partnerships, students will have opportunities for valuable, real-world experiences. In addition, we offer our in-house Teacher Academy.
